

The Women's Center of Jacksonville

The Women's Center of Jacksonville, founded in 1995 as a non-profit, community-based resource center dedicated to improving the lives of women, servs over 7,500 persons annually at their locations in Arlington, the S.A.F.E. Center in Southside, and satellite locations in the Jacksonville metro area.

As a not-for-profit organization, The Women's Center is always looking for ways to reduce expenses while simultaneously improving operational functions and making the most of their time and resources.

In 2017, the organization thought that they had found this in a premise-based Mitel VoIP solution with Mitel SIP telephones as it offered the functions and features that they needed, at a reasonable price. However, come late 2022, they were informed that their current vendor would no longer be supporting their premise-based product and they would need to upgrade to a cloud product. Then, tragedy struck when the Mitel platform had a major failure, becoming nonfunctional.
